Tournament Rules

System of Play:	The Tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Swiss System with 08 Rounds. All players will be playing together
Reporting Time:	All players should Report at 9.15 AM. Tournament will start at 9.30 AM.
Walk over Time:	15 Minutes. After which the opponent will be given a bye
Time Control:	15 Minutes + 05 seconds increment from move one for the entire game.
Tie Break:	1. Buchholz Cut-1, 2. Buchholz, 3. SB 4. Direct Encounter, 5. Greater Number of wins (forfeit included), 6. Greater number of wins with black.
Entry fees	Rupees 700 for regular players. Free for players with higher than 2000 FIDE rating in standard or Rapid format. Free for all U07 & U09 players who have a rating on standard or Rapid format
Free player registration	Players whose entry fees are waived off should register like a normal player. The entry fees will be refunded if the player comes and play all rounds. The entry fees will not be refunded for no-show.
Playing style	All players will be playing together in all rounds. The categories will be used only for prize distribution.
Prize:	Prizes shall not be shared. One player gets one higher prize. Cash prize is higher than trophy and Medal.
Cancellation Policy	100% refund for any cancellations done before 20.08.2026
Late Fees	Rupees 200 for payments done after 20.08.2026. Late fees shall not be refunded.
Protest:	Any protest against the decision of chief arbiter shall be made in the writing with the fee of Rs. 1000 within the 15 minutes of incident. Protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld. The decision of appeals committee is final and binding to all.
Appeals Committee:	A 5-member Appeals Committee (with 2 reserve) will be formed during the Players' meeting before the start of event.
