RULES & REGULATIONS



- **The tournament will be played as per the latest FIDE Laws of Chess.**
- The tournament will be conducted under the Swiss System.
- **Time Control:** 20 minutes + 2 seconds increment per player.
- **Total number of rounds:** 7 rounds.
- Players must report at the venue between **08:00 AM and 08:45 AM.**
- Players must be present at their board when the round starts.
- Players are requested to verify their name, category and details before the start of the first round.
- **Registration will be closed on 21/08/2026.**
- No entry will be accepted after the registration closing date or after the start of the first round.
- Mobile phones, smart watches and all electronic gadgets are strictly not allowed in the playing area.
- Parents, coaches and spectators are not allowed inside the playing area.
- Players must bring valid age proof for claiming age-category prizes.
- **Refreshments will be provided by the organisers.**
- Age-category prizes will be awarded only after verification of valid age proof.
- **Chess boards and chess clocks will be provided by the organisers.**



RULES & REGULATIONS



- **Tie-breaks will be applied in the following order:**
Buchholz Cut-1, Buchholz, Sonneborn-Berger, Direct Encounter, Number of Wins, Number of Games Won with Black.
- **One Player One Prize rule will be followed. If a player qualifies for more than one prize, the higher prize will be awarded**
- All disputes, if any, must be reported to the Chief Arbiter immediately before the next round pairing is published.
- **Registration fee once paid will be non-transferable and non-refundable, unless announced otherwise by the organisers.**
- The organisers will not be responsible for loss of personal belongings.
- **The schedule may be adjusted depending on the number of players and round duration.**
- Chief Arbiter's decision will be final and binding.
- The organisers reserve the right to make necessary changes if required.
- **E-Certificates will be provided to all participants.**
